

HAY MURRAY REGION 2 RESEARCH PROMOTION TROPHY

This award is named after Hayward Murray of the Montréal and Toronto chapters. He was the first president of ASHRAE Research Canada. This is a regional award and is named after the individual who initiated the paperwork to form a Canadian corporation called ASHRAE Research Canada [ARC] so businesses in Canada would have the same opportunity as in the USA for using their investment as a tax deduction.

The winner is selected by the Regional V-C for Research Promotion and is based on who is the best RP Chapter Chair using a number of factors: amount collected compared to prior years; total amount per assigned Society Members in chapter; size of the RP committee; etc.

The trophy is held for a year and is returned to the CRC for the next year's presentation.

The award was first presented at the Moncton 1998 CRC to the Windsor Chapter .
