REPORT OF RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE - REGIONAL MEETING  
REGION 2 - HELD AT MONTREAL, APRIL 20, 1959.

Whereas the Montreal Chapter has served as host to the annual chapter's Regional Meeting of the delegates Region 2 A.S.H.R.A.E.,

Whereas the Meeting had many memorable firsts in a very informative day of discussion to wit:

- (a) Our first President, Mr. Cecil Boling, A.S.H.R.A.E. gave his first address to the first Chapter's Regional Meeting held under A.S.H.R.A.E. sponsorship.
- (b) The Meeting was conducted in the first fully air conditioned hotel in Canada and the evening dinner held apparently in the first air conditioned room in Montreal.

Whereas the liquid refreshment flowed as freely as the Rivers after which the meeting rooms were named,

Whereas our morning deliberations were conducted with finesse by our Regional Director as a whole,

Whereas the following facts were established,

- (1) Winnipeg is not the geographical centre of Canada,
